The Training College established in the year 2005, named after the Great Guru Philosopher Sree Sankaracharya holds the vision to build up a Centre of Excellence in Teacher Education .The college is administered by Adi Sankara Trust which is patronized by Sree Sree Bharathi Theertha Mahaswamigal of Sringeri Saradapeedam, Sringeri, Karnataka. The college is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University,Kottayam and is recognized by NCTE,Bangalore.

We offer two years Bachelor of Education Programme of Mahatma Gandhi University. The course of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures and practical training. Practice teaching will be arranged during each semester in recognized schools near the college .Total numbers of seats is 100 in which 50% of the seats are under merit quota (as per Govt. rules) and the rest of the seats are in management quota.

The Core Subjects offered by the college:

1. English Education
2. Hindi Education
3. Mathematics Education
4. Natural Science Education
5. Physical Science Education
6. Social Science Education
7. Commerce Education

Eligibility:

Candidates should have passed BA / B.Sc degree exams under the 10+2+3 pattern with one main subject and two subsidiary subjects from M G University or any other university recognized by M G University as equivalent thereto for admission, subject to the stipulation regarding marks.

However the eligibility of candidates who have passed degree examination in double/triple main, Model II vocational and other specialized subjects/streams will be governed by rules and regulations of this university.

In the case of candidates who have passed examinations of other Universities, they will be admitted only if these examinations have been declared equivalent to the qualifying examinations of this University.

Choice of optional subjects

The optional subject for the B.Ed course should be the same as the one, which the student has selected as main subject for graduation, or the main subject for graduation conventionally recognized to be coming under the option chosen. In case, the main subject is

different from or conventionally considered as not coming under the optional opted for admission, a copy of the Certificate from any of the Universities in Kerala, stating that such degree is eligible for admission to that optional for B.Ed course, should be furnished along with the application.

Eligibility for different Optional subjects:

Languages

a) English: B A Degree with English language and Literature/Functional English/B.A Communicative English with 50% marks/CGPA-2 in Part III or B.A/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part I English and not less than 50% marks for Master's Degree in English Language and Literature.

b)Hindi: B A Degree with Hindi Language and Literature with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III or BA/ B.Sc with 50% marks for Part II Hindi and not less than 50% marks for Master's Degree in Hindi Language and Literature.

Other Optionals

a)Mathematics: B.Sc Degree with Mathematics/Statistics/Applied Statistics as main, with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III. Candidates with Statistics/Applied Statistics should have studied Mathematics as one of the subjects.

b)Physical sciences: B.Sc Degree with Physics/Chemistry/ Polymer Chemistry/B.Sc Geology/B.Sc Petrochemicals/ B.Sc Biochemistry/B.Sc Industrial Chemistry/ B.Sc Physics Model III – Electronics Equipment Maintenance main with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III

c)Natural sciences: B.Sc Degree with Botany/Zoology/Biochemistry/B.Sc Plant Science/Family & Community Science (with Zoology or Botany as subsidiary) / Aquaculture (with Biochemistry and Zoology as subsidiaries)/ Biotechnology/ Microbiology/Industrial Fish & Fisheries with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III.

d)Social science: BA Degree with History/Arabic and Islamic History main with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III or BA Degree with Geography/Politics/Economics/Sociology/ Psychology/Philosophy/West Asian Studies under Part III/ B.A degree in Museology and Archaeology and with 50% marks/ CGPA-2 in Part III.

e)Commerce: Candidates who have secured M.Com Degree with not less than 50% marks alone are eligible for admission to the B.Ed course in Commerce. Such candidates are not eligible for admission to any other B.Ed course

1.The minimum requirement for admission to B.Ed course is 50% marks /CGPA- in Bachelor's degree (Science/Arts subjects) in Part III).

2. SC/ST Candidates need only pass mark.

3. Candidates belonging to SE/BC/OEC will be given 5% relaxation in marks.

4. There will be no upper or lower age limit for admission to B.Ed course.

Admission procedure

Every candidate should apply for admission in prescribed application form, which can be had from the college office between 9.30am-4.00pm on payment of Rs.100 /-per form and prospectus or application and prospectus, can be downloaded from the college website.

Admission to merit seats are based on the rank list prepared by the college on the basis of marks of applicants obtained in the qualifying examination and other rules of admission prescribed by University and the Government.

Preparation of Rank list for merit quota will be based on the marks obtained for part 3 of the qualifying examination.

Weightage for Marks (Except for Commerce)

15 marks – First Class P.G Degree.

10 marks – Second Class P.G Degree.

5 marks – Third Class P.G Degree.

(In the same subject for which the candidates seeks admission)

10marks- N.C.C/N.S.S

Certificates / Documents to be submitted with application form.

1. Self attested copy of S.S.L.C/any relevant school records to prove the Date of Birth.
2. Self attested copy of mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examinations and degree/provisional certificate
3. Copy of Certificates in support of claim for communal reservation, in the application if applicable.

Certificates / Documents to be submitted during the time of interview for admission.

1. Original of S.S.L.C/any relevant school records to prove the Date of Birth.
2. Original the mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examinations and degree/ provisional certificate.
3. Original Certificates in support of claim for communal reservation, in the application if applicable.
4. Equivalency and eligibility certificate from Mahatma Gandhi University if applicable.
5. Migration Certificate in the case candidates from other universities, rather than Mahatma Gandhi University.
6. Transfer Certificate, Character and Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
7. 3 passport size colour photographs.
8. Candidates shall invariably be accompanied by parents/guardian at the time of interview.

If selected the candidates get himself / herself admitted at once, paying the fees fixed by fee regulatory committee.

The original certificates and SSLC book submitted to the college by the candidate at the time of admission will be returned only at the time his/her leaving the college after the course and only on clearing all the dues to the college. Candidates are therefore advised to keep with them duly attested copies of their all certificates.

Hostel facility will be available for the students.

All students are expected to follow the rules and regulation of the college strictly.
